Qualifications

Preferred Qualifications

- Florida certification in Educational Leadership, School Principal, Administration, or Administration and Supervision.
- Prior experience leading a classical liberal arts charter school, ideally K-12, with demonstrated success e.g., producing favorable academic grade outcomes over time.

Responsibilities

- Overseeing the academic performance of all students.
- Interviewing, hiring, and managing faculty at the school to ensure classical education is implemented effectively.
- Observing teachers at defined intervals, document results, and provide feedback as coach and supervisor.
- Communicating effectively and productively with students, teachers, and parents through regular meetings, email, social media, and monthly newsletters.
- Leading ongoing professional development for faculty.
- Ensuring student growth and high performance on statewide assessments, standardized assessments and any other district and school-based assessments that are implemented.
- Enabling faculty and staff to work as a system focused on student learning.
- Engaging in data analysis for instructional planning and improvement.
- Evaluating monitors and provides timely feedback to faculty on the effectiveness of instruction.
- Meeting with teachers, parents and students to diffuse challenging situations.
- Developing, implementing and monitoring outcomes of student achievement data to improve student learning.
- Creating a safe, clean, orderly learning environment.
- Collaborating with staff to achieve school improvement plan targets.
- Overseeing the school's Exceptional Student Education (ESE).

- Knowledge and fidelity of the classical liberal arts, its roots in the Western tradition, and its historical presence in American education prior to the 20th century.
- Knowledge of the craft of teaching, and the ability to teach well.

- Ability to communicate effectively in both oral and written forms.
- Ability to maintain a high degree of energy and personal productivity and to manage the productivity of others.
- Ability to prioritize and accomplish necessary tasks efficiently and effectively and have a proven record of excellent time management.
- Knowledge of personnel management, including recruiting and hiring, supervising and evaluating, terminating and conducting exit interviews, and individual and organizational development.
- Ability to create a climate and culture in which faculty are motivated to do their best to help the school achieve its goals.
- Knowledge of financial management principles, including budgeting, auditing, and controls.
- Understanding of Florida's accountability system for K-12 public schools; knowledge of Florida laws relevant to charter schools.
