THE BATTLE OF THERMOPYLAE in 480 BC, is one of the most epic battles involving extreme bravery that still resonates throughout history. Leonidas, King of the Spartans and commander-in-chief of the Greek forces, delayed the Persian army for three days in a rocky pass. King Leonidas sent his army away but 300 of his fellow Spartans stayed with him to fight and die for their country. Their sacrifice bought time for the retreat and tactical and political regrouping that would save Greece. This is one of the most famous acts of sheer courage and defiance in the face of overwhelming odds in history.

We now face a battle of similar magnitude in America. We're fighting for the freedom to ensure our next generation receives the education they need and deserve to lead our great nation. Cornerstone Classical Academy was built to meet this need and we are on the precipise of making CCA the premier educational institution in the city, state, and country.

The Spartan 300 Campaign will run from November 2021 to May of 2023 and will raise \$3 million dollars to build the CCA gymnasium. We are looking for 300 people who will donate \$500 a month over the next 20 months for a total of \$10,000.

It will allow CCA to compete in a wide range of sports and host games, hold large-scale events such as **graduation**, **tournaments**, **school dances and pep rallies**, and provide a venue for **theater**, **music and chorus productions**.



Our student body, parents, grandparents, and supporters of CCA can unite under the same roof to cheer on our boys' and girls' sports teams, watch their child perform a Shakespeare play, and see our graduates accept their diploma in their caps and gowns.



With a large stage inside the Gymnasium, performances can be held year-round for plays, dance recitals, art shows, and other school-related assemblies.



The Gymnasium will be a place for <u>all students</u> to improve their **overall health and will impact the culture of excellence rooted in our 7 school virtues**: respect, responsibility, courage, self government, humility, perseverance, and integrity.
